

Getting Started

payment accepted all shift long

- Pay at the **YBC cart**, not the front desk, after your child is settled at the lane
- Find out where you bowl each week by consulting the lane sheet posted beside the cart
- Visit the **Youth Bowling** page on our website to access the lane sheet at home
- Printed lane sheets are available at the cart, so please take one for future reference

Late Arrivals

bowling starts at 10:00 am sharp

- Late bowlers arriving after the **4th frame** cannot play until the second game begins
- If you miss the first game, it can be bowled after your shift ends to avoid disruption

Bowling Off

“bank” scores to use when absent

- Bowl your games **in advance** and record those scores on a YBC sheet at the front desk
- Counts toward Cresting and team scores, but not tournaments or individual trophies
- Without banked scores a banquet fee of **\$3.00** will be charged for every week missed

Bowling Shoes

shoe racks are against back wall

- Bowling shoes **must** be worn on the lanes, a rule applying to bowlers and helpers
- Please help yourself to a **free** pair of rental shoes before assisting your child on the lane

Seating Options

tables are reserved for bowlers

- Spectators are kindly asked to stay behind the black line, using a folding chair for seating

Personal Bowling Balls

purchased for sole individual use

- Blue **house balls** are for public use while personal balls are for private use by one bowler

Wet Floors

obey the black “no wet shoes” line

- Wet floors pose a safety hazard, especially near the tables and on the lanes
- Bowling shoes are designed to slide with ease, so any wetness can cause a serious fall
- A thick black line on the floor marks the beginning of our “no wet shoes” zone
- Remove any wet footwear and place them against the back wall or on a provided mat
- Carry bowling shoes to the table area, do not walk there after changing into rentals
- If a **spill** occurs at your table, please alert a volunteer or NEB’s employee immediately

Foul Lines

record any fouls on score sheet

- Foul lines will be “activated” on **Saturday, October 1st**, so practice staying behind them
- Touching the foul line will count as a penalty and reduce your score from October on
- Starting on October 1st, any fouls must be manually recorded on the score sheet
- Write an “F” beside the bowler’s name each and every time a foul is triggered

- Please leave your completed score sheet on the table before you leave NEB’s
